Should I be joining Lighthouse Probus?

Why is it mainly a 'couples' club?

Mountains, we cannot build the fellowship and friendship network that we are looking to
promote.

If I am Snowbird or frequent traveler, should I join Lighthouse Probus?

• Yes, you should consider joining if you are mainly resident in the area. Many of our members are frequent travelers (Snowbirds, Sunbirds, Cruisers, etc.) but as residents of the area they attend many events and activities during the rest of the year.

• If you are not retired or semi-retired in the area, we are happy to add you to our waiting list. We would, however, ask you not to join the Club until you feel you can participate in the activities and events that our volunteer members arrange as you may be taking the place of another potential member who is retired, recognizing that we have a limited membership.
